After studying Business Management at the University of Münster and Munich, Ingeborg Neumann spent 12 years with the accounting company Arthur Andersen, most recently as a chartered accountant and partner.

In 1997 Ingeborg Neumann founded the Peppermint Group based in Berlin. Peppermint develops innovative textiles across the entire value chain for the corporate, protection, mobility, industrial, interior and fashion sectors. With over 600 employees and seven locations in Europe – four of them in Germany – the Peppermint Group generates an annual turnover of approx. €90 million.

Since 2000, Ingeborg Neumann has also been the investor and fund manager of two venture capital funds.

Her private interest is primarily in the fine arts, in particular the support of young artists. She is also a dedicated collector and holds various honorary posts.
